REMINDERS

<u>Masks</u> – Don't forget, masks need to fit properly in order to be effective. Masks should fully cover the mouth and nose, and not slide down. If your mask is too big, please either adjust it

or get one that fits properly. Additionally, masks with valves/vents are **not** allowed, per Archdiocesan guidelines.

Extended Care - Extended Care will now be billed through your FACTS account, and payments will be made through FACTS. Please wait to pay until the charges appear on your FACTS account, as pre-payment makes keeping track of payments difficult. Illness / Absences from School – if your child is ill, you need to report him/her absent to the office. If a child shows any symptoms of COVID during the school day, he/she will be sent home. In order to return, either a doctor's note, negative Covid test result, or 10 days of quarantine since symptoms appeared is required. If a student has been exposed to someone that has been diagnosed with Covid, he/she will need to quarantine for 14 days. **If your child or anyone in your household tests positive for Covid, please notify the school immediately so that we can make arrangements to begin e-learning for individuals or cohorts as needed.** It is essential that the office is notified of Covid / Covid exposure. We will work with you to navigate the policies. We will also help you get connected to remote learning and arrange for pick up of books/materials so that your child is able to work at home while quarantined.

Earlier this month, an Agreement to Adhere to Covid Protocols went out via email. Please sign and return this form if you have not already done so.

A summary of our Covid protocols went home previously with students (it is included in the links from August 27 under the Thursday Thoughts tab on our website as well). *Please note, these can be subject to change based on current guidelines from local health authorities.*
