<u>Progress Reports</u> - We are half-way through the 1st Trimester! Paper progress reports are going home for students in grades 1 & 2 today. **Grades 3-8 will view their grades in**PowerSchool and will return a signed acknowledgement form indicating they have reviewed

<u>Parent-Teacher Conferences</u> - This year, conferences will be held via Zoom (On **Friday**, **October 23**rd), as in-person meetings are not allowed yet. Sign-ups will begin soon Stay tuned for an email with directions on how to sign-up for your time.

<u>GRADES/HONOR ROLL</u> - Please note, the grade scale for Specials Classes (Physical Education, Fine Arts, Spanish, Technology) has changed. **These classes are now using the +, S, and – grade scale.**

For the A/High Honor Roll, Grades 4-8 students need to have all A's in the subject areas still being graded, and +'s in the Specials.

For the B Honor Roll, Grades 4-8 students need to earn a combo of A's and B's (no C's or lower), and have all +'s and S's (no -'s) in the Specials.

Gym Uniforms - Please make sure you have the correct gym uniform! Last year was the final transition year for uniforms. This year, all gym uniforms should be the navy blue ones, as offered through **Dennis Uniform**. **If you do not have the correct uniform, this will start to be reflected in your grade.** Even though we had to say farewell to Mrs. Ward, Mrs. Folino and Ms. Margaret will be covering gym classes so that students still have the opportunity to exercise and learn healthy habits during the school day.

<u>Sweaters/Uniforms</u> - As the weather is getting colder, please remember to dress appropriately. Make sure to bring your St. Ferdinand School fleece sweater jacket (the Dennis Uniform one) to wear during the school day. Due to COVID, we do need to keep the windows open to provide more ventilation – and as the temperature drops outside, so does the temperature in the classroom.

REMINDERS

<u>Masks</u> – Don't forget, masks need to fit properly in order to be effective. <u>Masks should fully</u> cover the mouth and nose, and not slide down. If your mask is too big, please either adjust it

or get one that fits properly. Additionally, masks with valves/vents are **not** allowed, per Archdiocesan guidelines.

<u>Extended Care</u> - Extended Care will now be billed through your FACTS account, and payments will be made through FACTS. Please wait to pay until the charges appear on your FACTS account, as pre-payment makes keeping track of payments difficult. <u>Illness / Absences from School</u> – if your child is ill, you need to report him/her absent to the office. If a child shows any symptoms of COVID during the school day, he/she will be sent home. In order to return, either a doctor's note, negative Covid test result, or 10 days of quarantine since symptoms appeared is required. If a student has been exposed to someone that has been diagnosed with Covid, he/she will need to quarantine for 14 days. If your child or anyone in your household tests positive for Covid, please notify the school immediately so that we can make arrangements to begin e-learning for individuals or cohorts as needed. It is essential that the office is notified of Covid / Covid exposure. We will work with you to navigate the policies. We will also help you get connected to remote learning and arrange for pick up of books/materials so that your child is able to work at home while quarantined.

Earlier this month, an Agreement to Adhere to Covid Protocols went out via email. Please sign and return this form if you have not already done so.
