<u>Valentines Day</u> - Just a reminder – if you are bringing in treats (no food!) for the class, these are due by Thursday, February 4<sup>th</sup>. These allows items enough time to quarantine. Pencils, stickers, cards, small notepads, coloring books, etc. are all examples of allowable items.

<u>Donate to a Tax Credit Scholarship</u> Give the gift of Catholic education. Triple your impact of a tax credit scholarship with the 2-for-1 matching gift program. To help donations have even more impact in 2021/22, several donors have agreed to pool their resources and offer a 2-for-1 matching gift program to the more than 160 schools run by the Archdiocese of Chicago. The matching pool fund is at \$2.8 million with funds still being actively raised. This means for every dollar designated to a qualifying school through the Empower Illinois scholarship granting organization between Dec. 1, 2020 and Feb. 28, 2021, the school will receive two dollars in matching funds. The donations are capped at \$50,000 per school. <u>GRADES/HONOR ROLL</u> - Please note, the grade scale for Specials Classes (Physical Education, Fine Arts, Spanish, Technology) has changed. **These classes are now using the +, S, and – grade scale**.

- S (satisfactory work)
- (unsatisfactory work)

For the A/High Honor Roll, Grades 4-8 students need to have all A's in the subject areas still being graded, and +'s in the Specials.

For the B Honor Roll, Grades 4-8 students need to earn a combo of A's and B's (no C's or lower), and have all +'s and S's (no -'s) in the Specials.

**Gym Uniforms** - Please make sure you have the correct gym uniform! Last year was the final transition year for uniforms. This year, all gym uniforms should be the navy blue ones, as offered through **Dennis Uniform**. If you do not have the correct uniform, this will start to be reflected in your grade.

<u>Sweaters/ Uniforms</u> - As the weather is getting colder, please remember to dress appropriately ... students should now be in pants, NOT walking shorts. Make sure to bring your St. Ferdinand School fleece sweater jacket (the Dennis Uniform one) to wear during the school day. Due to COVID, we do need to keep the windows open to provide more ventilation – and as the temperature drops outside, so does the temperature in the classroom.
